Foreign policy is the most important issue facing the United States today. For the last six years, our foreign policy has led to a quagmire in Iraq where none of our regional allies are willing to assist. The costs of the war is increasing our federal deficit and the national debt. The combined weight of the federal deficit, record trade deficit, and slowing housing market will be drag on the economy for the foreseeable future without even considering the loss of productive lives and diversion of funding to reconstruct Iraq instead of maintaining infrastructure in the US. The effects of the fiasco in Iraq will be felt in our military, domestic policy, and foreign policy for years after it is over, and the war in Iraq will last at least until the end of the Bush administration, according to the President. Second, announcing Iran and North Korea as part of the "Axis of Evil" has unsurprisingly spurred them to take a hostile stance. North Korea has completed a test of a nuclear weapon when previously the US was able to persuade them not to even attempt to develop a nuclear weapon. And the rhetoric with Iran over its nuclear energy program is almost an invitation for them to develop nuclear weapons even if they did not want to originally. Of course, the greatest threat to the US does not come directly from North Korea and Iran by way of nuclear-tipped missiles from North Korea or Iran, but through a commercial transport carrying a nuclear parcel from a group that bought such technology from North Korea or Iran. And with our present approach of "tough talk," neither country will agree to inspections. Third, we seem to have snatched defeat from the jaws of victory in Afghanistan. The Taliban has made a resurgence lately, and now our troops are too tied down in Iraq to be able to deal with the situation. Our NATO allies are having a difficult time in fighting Taliban insurgents. Also, Kharzai has not been able to wrest control away from local warlords and establish national authority throughout the country. As a result, Afghanistan is now growing more opium than ever before and the profits made help fund the Taliban insurgents and probably Al Qaeda. And the failure to subdue Al Qaeda and capture bin Laden five years after the attacks on the US is a continuing embarrassment for the most powerful nation in the world. Essentially, a group of amateur guerilla fighters is able to continue operating despite the efforts of the most powerful and technologically advanced military in the world.	MOONBAT
